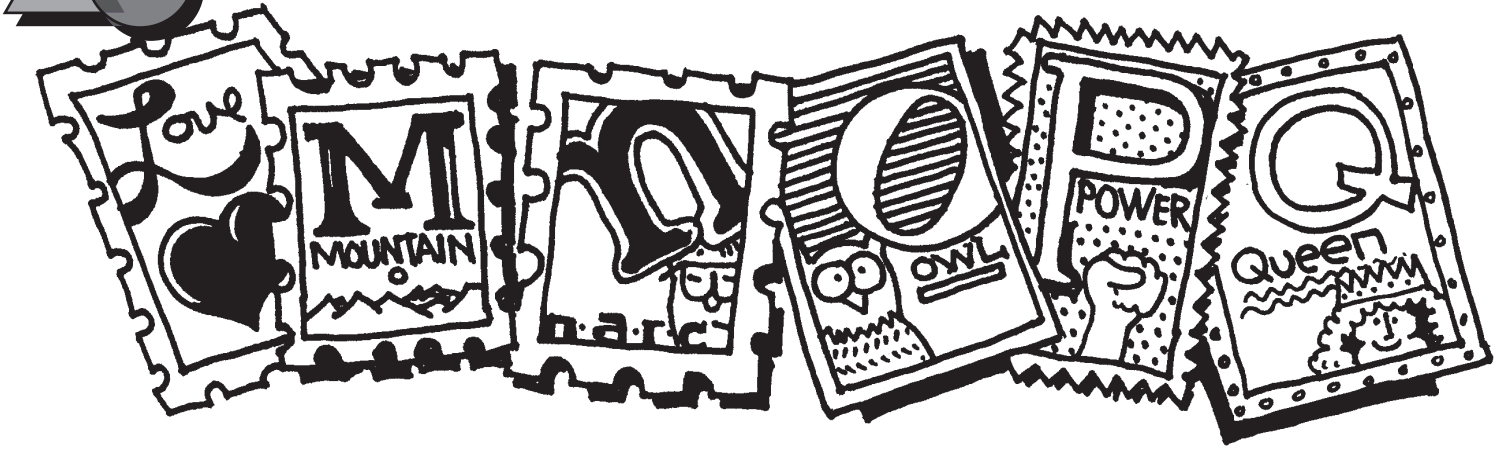


Font "Stamp" Project

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Each of you will be required to design 10 stamps which will feature 10 of your favorite fonts. To start we will (today) review many of the available fonts to choose from. Each stamp design will utilize a different font choice and different letter/word combination. Along with these requirements each stamp will also have a form of imagery. The imagery portion can be an illustration or photograph, however, I am encouraging you to do your own illustration, which I will discuss (further) in a minute.

To explain further, each stamp will have a different font and different letter. Each letter (in turn) will represent a word which will be the subject matter for your illustration. Try to keep some continuity with your design series, since you will be featuring separate fonts this may be a challenge. The best way to start is by brainstorming words and thumbnails with your design and layout ideas. Also try to choose a broad enough subject such as automobiles, music, countries, sports, animals etc.etc.

Create your own stamp boarder and use it throughout the project, be creative and professional here, these are meant to look like real stamps, not just a quick design in a box. Make each design should be 5 x 6 ",(not including the border) however if you have a different size or proportion you would like to use feel free to do so, don't go any smaller but you can alternate this standard size for expanded creativity.
